- II. Benefits of the trust The benefits of the Trust shall be open to all public irrespective of caste, colour, sex, creed or religion.
- III. Trust Property The Trust property shall consist of the initial trust found contributed by the founder members.
- IV. Board of Trustees(Board of Management) The Trust shall comprise of founder trustees, hereditary trustees and co- operated trustees. The board of Trustees shall co- operated to eminent person of the community who will be useful to the Trust for mobilization of resources and contribute a sum of Rs. 10000 /- towards the corpus fund. Co Opted trustees shall be appointed for a period of one year which can be extended for two more consecutive years, which shall be decided by the chairman of the Board of Trustees. The Co opted Trustees shall have al powers and authority of life time trustees. The management and control of the trust and trust properties shall rest in the chairman of the Board of Trustees. The board of Trustees, chairman, secretary, treasure and managing trustees. The following shall be the first board of trustees with their name, address and designations.

- V. Power of the Trustees- The founder Trustee shall hold office for life and upon their death or disability they are entitled to nominate a person of their kin. The first Board of Trustees can not be removed or replace and upon their death or disability the legal heir or nominated person in their family shall hold office in their place. The Trustees shall have to power and authority to administer the trust and its properties and to do all acts, deeds and thinks to promote the objects of the Trust. The Trustees shall have power and authority for the purpose of this Trust.
 - a. To invest the funds of the Trust in the modes prescribed under the provisions of the sections 13 (1) (d) read with section 11(5) of the income tax act 1961.
 - b. To borrow money with or without security and to repay the same.
 - c. Enter into contracts vary and rescind them.

- d. To open bank accounts and provide for operation their on from time to time.
- e. To receive gifts, grants, endowments and donations in cash or kind.
- f. To institute , prosecute and defend all legal suits and other proceedings.
- g. To appear and act before courts, tribunals, governmental tax and other public authorities.
- h. To appoint, terminate, dismiss, suspend and otherwise deal with the employees of the Trust and its institutions.
- i. To apply the properties and funds of the trust for all or any of the objects for which the Trust is established as may be determined by the Trustees from time to time.
- j. To decide from time to time the activities and projects to be undertaken for furfilling the object of the Trust.





- k. To frame rules and bye laws for the management for the trust and its properties and proceedings and to amend or rescind them from time to time subject to clause 15 below.
- I. To incur al necessary expenses connected with the Trust.
- m. The founder members and the Chairman are authorized to execute any document with or without registration including amendments to the Trust deed.
- VI. Power and Duties of Individual office bearers
 - i. Founder members The founder members shall have power
 - a. To call for the meetings of the Board of Trustees or the office bearers in special circumstances.
 - b. To have supervision Trust funds.
 - c. To exercise casting vote in case of a tie in any matter in the meetings of the Board of Trustees or office bearers.
 - d. To make needful decisions along with other office bearers in times of emergency for the promotion of the objects of the Trust.
 - e. To mobilize funds for the trust.
 - ii. Chairman / Vice Chairman The Chairman shall have power
 - a. To call for and preside overall meetings of the Board of Trustees and of the office bearers of the Trust.
 - b. To operate banking accounts with the treasurer and/or secretary of the Trust.
 - c. To address letters to the dignitaries on important matters.
 - d. To mobilize funds for the Trust.
 - e. The chairman shall have superintending powers on all matters concerning the Trust.
 - f. To make rules and regulations for the conduct of the business of the trust as well as for the governance and conduct of the institutions as established by them.
 - h. The chairman along with Trustees shall have the power to create such other legal institution and entitles as may be necessary in their opinion to effectively carry out the objects of the Trust.
 - i. To employ servants, agents and secure services of professional people like advocate, auditors etc. and to create a cadre and to appoint staff for the institutions including teaching and on teaching created by the Trust along with rules.

 - a. To operate the bank account of the trust along with the Chairman of the Secretary.
 - b. To maintain or cause to be maintained all books of account as per the directions of the board of trustees and / or office bearers of the trust.
 - c. To prepare or cause to be prepared the statement of receipts and payments incurred for every month and place the same before the office bearers of the trust with the co - operation and assistance of the secretary.
 - d. To maintain or cause to be maintained all necessary books of accounts vouchers and other connected document in the office of the trust.
 - e. To submit or COZ to be submitted his accounts for internal audits and annual audits and prepare or cause to be prepared the annual statement of accounts including receipts and payments, income and expenditure and balance sheet and place the same for the approval of the trustees of the trust and after approval circulate the same among al the trustees.
 - f. The custodian of the rust funds.
 - g. To mobilize funds for the trust.
- v. Secretary The Secretary shall have power
 - a. To be the executive officer of the trust.
 - b. Accept all notice summons and writs.

c. To Sue Or be Sued for and on behalf of the trust unless otherwise decided.

d. To function as per the direction of the Chairman and the board of trustees, in that order.

e. To operate bank accounts along with the treasurer of the chairman.

f. To provide relevant papers with the notice of the Chairman to any trustee.

g. To maintain minutes of the proceedings of the meeting of the board of trustees or the $\frac{1}{4}$ office bearers.

INVESTEMENT -VII.

The trust funds shall be invested in the modes specified under the i. provisions of section 13(1)(d) read with section 11(5) of the income tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time.

- To apply and use the funds of the trust for all or any of the object of the ii. trust.
- To receive any money or other assets in any shape or form as and when iii. given by the author of the trust of any other persons as if or donation and to hold the same as part of the capital fund of the trust it such donor expresses his desire to show treat the same or to make it available for the application to further the objects of the trust treating the same as income of the trust.
- To acquire on lease or purchase or otherwise and to sell, mortgage hire iv. lease or transfer or in any other manner whatsoever, movable or immovable properties to construct hostels, schools, and /or other buildings and to carry out other improvements there for the purpose of the trust and to manage properties, movable and immovable and all other assets of the trust and to mortgage them, o repay loans or otherwise to deal generally with the assets for the purpose of the trust, to let out lease, mortgage, charge or rand license to use any property belonging to the trust for such rent or compensation and on such terms and conditions as the board of trustees may think fit.
- To borrow take loan from banks, financial institutions borrow or raise any ٧. money that may be required by the trust for the achievement of its object upon such terms as may be deemed advisable and in particular by the issue of promissory notes or by mortgage or charge on all or any part of the immovable or movable assets belonging to the trust.
- To open accounts of any nature in any nationalized / private bank/ s and vi. operate such account/s or authorize operations of the said account by the Chairman, secretary and treasurer(Any two of the three) Jointly.
- To do all other acts deeds, matters and things which may deemed vii. necessary for caring out the objects of the trust of its administration.
- VIII. DELEGATION The board of trustees may from time to time delegate to one or more of their body such of their powers and duties as they deem fit subject nevertheless of their retaining the ultimate control and supervision.





- IX. Accounts The trustees shall duly maintain true and correct accounts o all assets, liabilities, receipts and expense of the trust and a correct record of the meetings and deliberations. The year of account of the trust shall be the 1st of April to the 31st Of March every year. It shall however be opened to the trustees to change the year of account if they find it more convenient to do so.
- X. Indemnity The trustees shall be indemnified against any action or proceedings, cost or claim, demand or liability for anything done by them in good faith, pursuant to the power and authority vested in them under this deed.
- XI. Amendments to the trust deed :- No amendments to this trust deed or any rules or regulations framed by the trustees, shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of section 2 (15), 11- 13 and 80 G of the in come tax act 1961. Subject to the above, the trustees may amend the provisions of the trust deed, provided however no amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the commissioner of income tax.
- XII. Irrevocable :- The trust formed shall be irrevocable.
- XIII. Dissolution of the trust :- In the event of dissolution or winding up of the trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the trustees but the same shall be transferred to another charitable trust, society, association, or institute whose objects are similar to those of this trust and which enjoys recognition under section 80 of Income Tax Act 1961.
- XIV. Utilization of the funds and income of the trust :- The funds and income of the trust shall be utilized for the achievement of the objects of the trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to the trustees by the way of profit interest or dividend the trustees who render fulfill professional or other services to the trust shall be paid a honorium amount monthly.
- XV. Audit : The board of trustees shall get the accounts of the trust duly audited every year by a Chartered Accountant.
- XVI. Working Area:- Jharkhand.
